



Artists' Market Application 2010

Date: July 10, 2010

Time: 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Location: Old Art Building in Leland

Eligible media: All pieces must be original (conceived and executed by the applicant). We encourage fine arts, quality artisans and gourmet foods. Booths are rented based on eligibility and on a first come, first serve basis. We do not accept applicants with commercial molds, patterns, kits, etc. New artists must include a photo of their artwork with this application.

Exhibit space: Each participant will be allotted a square 10'x10' on the lawn or approximately 9'x9' inside the art building. A two-person team or partnership may qualify as a single exhibitor if this is clearly stated at the time of application.

Fee: Exhibit fee for an outdoor space on the front lawn is \$75. Additional outdoor booths may be available on Cedar Street this year at \$75. A space inside the art building is \$100 and includes some hanging wall space. Booths in the "Annex" behind the art building are \$60. Some 6' or 8' tables may be reserved for an additional \$10. Make check payable to LCCC and send with application to **LCCC, PO Box 883, Leland MI 49654**. No refunds for cancellations received after May 1. A postcard confirmation will be sent when the market is full or by mid-June with a reminder of date/time.

Set-up: Set up time will be on Saturday morning beginning at 7:30-10:00 AM. You may set up a tent the night before but no security will be provided.

Rules: Artists/designated seller must be present for the duration of the show. No vehicles & no dogs allowed on the grounds of the Old Art Building. Vehicles must be parked at least two blocks away after unloading.
