The Playboys are dedicated to keeping the Cajun/Zydeco/Creole music alive with live performances for two steppin’, waltzing, and smoking red hot zydeco dancing. French lyrics are common in many of the tunes they sing in the tradition of Amede Ardoin, Bois Sec, Canray Fontenot, and many others for an authentic Louisiana music experience.

The ten-button diatonic accordion of K. Jones is the driving force of their music, with Jonah Powell on fiddle, Jamie Bernard on the drums, and Dan Johansson on bass. Mark Stoltz spreads this contagious music on the scrub board and triangle driving the beat...
